### INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Applicants should be a minimum of 17 years of age and turning 18 during the first year of study with TAFE Queensland. International students who are under 18 years of age and are applying for a student visa are required by the Australian Department of Home Affairs to have adequate welfare arrangements in place.

**TOEFL-iBT** : A minimum score 94 and a minimum score in each section of the test 24 for listening, reading and writing and 23 for speaking.

**Pearson's Test of English (PTE)** - A minimum overall score of 66 in listening, reading and speaking and a minimum score of 56 in writing.

**OET** - A minimum score of B in listening, reading, speaking and a minimum score of C+ in writing.
